Classes will include play, group activities, and brief teacher-led instruction. Topics will include:

- Making friends
- Emotional regulation
- Collaboration
- Volume control
- Peer communication
- Turn taking
- · Problem-solving strategies

The sessions will be held at Center for Developing Minds in our new Early Learning Clinic. Course fee is \$150 per class, for 10-12 week sessions. Classes are carefully curated to benefit all participants and class size is limited to provide students with personalized attention.
