Center for Developing Mind's Early Learning Clinic provides services and supports for parents and caregivers of young children with a wide range of neurodevelopmental variations, behavior difficulties, and social struggles, including ASD, ADHD, and Down syndrome.

SERVICES

Peer Playgroups

Small play-based groups that meet weekly for children ages 2-8 years with ASD and difficulties with navigating social interactions.

Inclusive Playschool!

Weekday classes that provide targeted early intervention for children likely to be unsuccessful in a traditional daycare or preschool setting. Children receive completely individualized, custom curriculum with specific goals for all domains: cognition, social-emotional, physical, communication, and adaptive behavior. Carefully curated groups are selected to best support each student, ages 2-5 years.

Grown-up & Me Groups

Weekly class of caregiver(s) and child designed to teach parenting skills and strategies, provide support and understanding, in a fun and enjoyable playgroup setting.

Child Therapy

Treatment for families with young children who have trauma, depression, anxiety, and behavioral and social issues, utilizing CBT, art and play therapy.

Online Parenting SCRIPT Class

An 8-session class, offered each quarter, that teaches practical tips for improving parenting skills, reducing power struggles, and boosting parent confidence.
